Ders Tanımı / Course Description		Bu ders zorunlu ortak bir ders olarak tüm fakültelere İngilizce olarak sunulmakta olan bir derstir. Lozan antlaşmasından modern Türkiye Cumhuriyetinin kuruluşuna kadar olan dönemi kapsamakla birlikte, uzaktan öğretim modeli ile tasarlanmış bir derstir.					
Dersin Amaçları / Course Objectives		Beside discussing the definition of the term “Revolution” by giving some examples such as French and Russian Revolutions, this course mainly focuses on the historical process that laid the basis of the foundation of Modern Turkey. In this context, after presenting a concise political history of the Ottoman Empire and its state mechanism, the political, social and economical developments between the Sultan Selim III Period (1789-1808) and the proclamation of Republic of Turkey by Mustafa Kemal Ataturk in 1923, are examined. The course focuses mainly on the political, cultural, economical and judiciary reforms that shaped the Modern Turkey, founded by Mustafa Kemal Ataturk. The Six Principles of Ataturk and Kemalizm are also investigated. The place of the Republic of Turkey in the International Political System and Turkish Foreign Policy during Ataturk Era, are the other focus points in the course.
