Learning Outcomes	<p>After the completion of this course, the student will be able to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ use the basic vocabulary of the German language ▶ express themselves in German, explain a situation, a problem and make request in full sentences ▶ use the correct conjugation pattern (affirmative, negative sentences and question) – present tense ▶ Pronounce and spell German words correctly, read basic information in German ▶ Complete reading and listening comprehension exercises in German 					
Course Description	<p>The students are completing one chapter each week from the book Hallo (Switzerland) . Each chapter include a vocabulary list, a new grammar point and 6 pages of exercises. The exercises are supported by the 4 competences (reading, speaking, writing and listening). In addition to the online meeting/ face to face lectures each chapter contains an additional document, with notes, important grammar points, visualization, etc. Each week, the students have to attend the online meetings/ face to face lectures, where the grammar points will be explained, supported by a PowerPoint and all questions can be asked by going through the whole chapter. The recorded online meeting, as well as all material will be uploaded on the UZEM platform.</p>					
Course Objectives	<p>This course aims to raise the interest in the students of the 5 language learning goals * of the German language. The max. 8 semester course trains to participate in conversations on personal interest and familiar topics. Also, the ability to handle short social interactions in everyday situations or present topics related to personal interest and everyday life, this reverts to all 4 competences. *Communication, Cultures, Connections, Comparisons and Communities</p>
